

VPT-2 (Verbal Power Test)

Questions are not listed in order of difficulty. Use of references, including the internet, is allowed. Collaborating with others or sharing answers is prohibited. There is no time restriction and two submissions are allowed. <u>No</u> <u>submission fee</u> is required. There are no penalties for wrong answers or unanswered questions. You should spend at least half an hour answering each question. Your answers for 'Verbal Associations' questions will not include real or fictional names of: people, buildings or place names where people live (villages, towns, cities, and countries/states). This will streamline your research time or thoughts somewhat, through placing less emphasis on basic factual information. You will therefore devote less time to lower-level thinking skills.

Send your answers to Kirk Raymond Butt (highrangeiqtests@outlook.com) in an email. Your solutions (numbered 1 to 32) can be included directly in your email or may be attached as a PDF or text file. Include your scores on previous high range verbal untimed tests (optional). You need to include a photocopy or scan of your ID to verify your identity. You may disguise part of your ID but name, age (18 or older), and country of origin should be visible. Your score report (indicating raw score and IQ) along with a certificate is free of charge. Waiting time is normally less than 1 week.

PART 1. ODD-ONE-OUT:

Which one of the four words in each question does not belong with the others. Written explanations are not required.

Examples - DOG, ZEBRA, CAT, HAMSTER = ZEBRA (A zebra is not a tame animal kept as a pet.)

Many questions offer a hint, through the inclusion of a number in parentheses to indicate the number of letters in your 1-word answer.
